

Faculty Position at the Institute of Advanced Sciences

Institute of Advanced Sciences (Dartmouth, USA) has opening for a faculty position at the Assistant Professor level in Vedic Sciences and Indian philosophy. The position will be based in India, with occasional visit to the US campus located in New England. The faculty member will be heavily involved in research and professional activities related to Indic traditions, although there will be opportunity to participate in teaching courses primarily through distance technology. The research areas will include, without limitation, Indian philosophy, languages, traditional sciences, music and dance, indigenous socio-political system, indigenous econo-environment, and traditional healthcare. Professional activities will include organizing seminars, workshops, conferences, and taking leadership in professional organizations. Teaching will be in the area of the faculty member's expertise and interdisciplinary courses.

A suitable candidate will have a PhD related to one of the areas mentioned above, and experience in research and professional activities as demonstrated by publications and track record of past work. The candidate should be fluent in English and at least one of the Indian languages. Salary will be commensurate with qualification and experience.

Application package should include a statement of interest in teaching, research, and professional activities, a curriculum vitae, names of 3-5 references, all submitted electronically to Professor Bal Ram Singh at bsingh@inads.org. The screening and interviews will start on March 16, 2015, and will continue until the position is filled.
