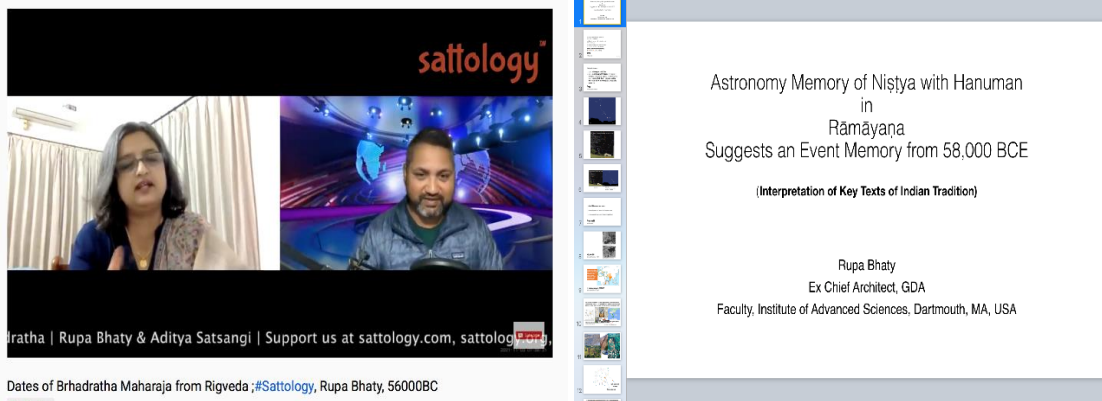


Monthly Activity Report of School of Indic Studies, INADS November, 2021

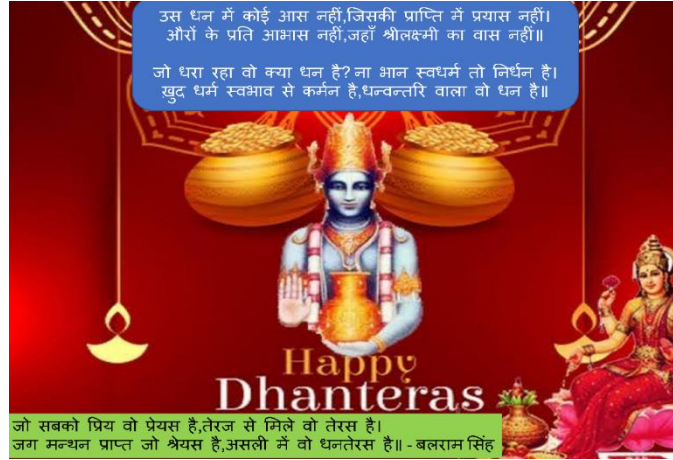
