So, the features and traits of eleven rudras were well expressed by invited speakers for guiding boys in the world to grow and realize their full potential in the same vein as Nava Durga. INADS faculty members Sh. Nilesh Oak and Dr. Umesh Kumar Singh were also among the invited speakers. The event also included one hour 'Ram-Katha-Vachan'. Prof. Bal Ram Singh, Dr. Aparna (Dhir) Khandelwal and Sh. Alok Kumar Dwivedi were the representatives of the program.
